1 DESCRIPTIVE SUMMARY

Creator: Ruth Enis (1928-)

Title: Professor Ruth Enis Collection

Dates: 1960s-2000s

Abstract:

The materials in this collection reflect Enis' work as scholar, teacher, and as practitioner of landscape architecture. It displays her work as a professor of landscape architecture in the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning at the Technion – Israel Institute of Technology, her devotion to research and teaching on the history of landscape architecture in general and in Israel in particular. Her most important historical studies are on landscape in Kibbutzim, and on a large number of Israeli graduates from the Ahlem Agriculture and Horticulture School in Germany and their vital impact on the Zionist creation of designed landscapes. The collection also holds Enis' professional work as a landscape designer, revealing her involvement in the creation of the Israeli landscape, especially her planning of school yards and Kibbutzim landscapes.

The collection described here is a fragment of Enis' extensive archive, the rest of which is located in her private house. The materials arranged in this collection were given to the guardianship of Professor Nurit Lissovsky at the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning, the Technion – Israel Institute of Technology, Haifa, and are held at the Architectural Heritage Research Center and managed by the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning Library.

2 BIOGRAPHICAL NOTE:

Ruth Enis was born in 1928, in Romania, to a Jewish family. In 1937, she immigrated to Palestine with her parents and brother and settled in Tel Aviv. In 1939, during a visit to her maternal grandmother with her mother, World War II broke out and she was unable to return to Palestine. During the war, she was deported together with her mother to a work camp in the Ukraine. With her father's efforts and Red Cross involvement, they were finally able to return to Palestine in 1943.

The 15-year-old Enis studied in the youth village in Ben Shemen (1944-1945) where she was introduced to gardening, and finished her high school diploma at the Herzliya Hebrew Gymnasium in Tel Aviv (1946-1947). She started working as a draftsman in the office of renowned architect Zeev Rechter (1947-1948) and joined the *Haganah* (a Zionist military organization operating during British Mandate of Palestine). After the State of Israel was established in 1948, she served in the Israeli army (1948-1949).

In 1954, Enis received her B.Arch from the faculty of Architecture at the Technion. She was one of the first female master students at the faculty of architecture, receiving her degree in urban planning in 1956 under Professor Alexander Klein. Her thesis dealt with the planning of open spaces of schools in the city. After graduation, Enis worked as a teaching and research assistant to Prof. Klein and later with Haim Latte who introduced her to landscape architecture. Latte was a graduate of the Ahlem School in Germany, a prolific writer, teacher and garden designer. Together they designed Kibbutzim gardens (e.g. Ayelet HaShachar, Geva, Shomrat, and others) as well as private gardens.

In 1958, she travelled to the Netherlands, where her husband enrolled at a PhD program and she studied towards a professional diploma in garden design. She designed the biblical garden at the international garden exhibit in Rotterdam (the Floriade-60) and was appointed as the chief landscape architect for the garden department in The Hague municipality (1960-1964), where she was involved in the master plan for playgrounds, sport grounds and recreational facilities, and in detailed plans for several municipal gardens.

In 1965, she returned to Israel and opened a private practice in landscape architecture, designing numerous projects across Israel, including a plan for Kiryat Yam (1964-67), two landscape plans for colleges (Rupin, 1964-1972; Tel Hai, 1968-1971), plans for the rehabilitation of several quarries (Emek Quarry 1969-70, Vered 1969-70, Natuf 1975-76, Migdal Zedek, 1976-78), and site plans for several nature reserves (Mt. Carmel, Mt. Miron 1969-70, Hulah 1970-72), to name a few.

Enis began her academic career in 1970, working on a curriculum for a landscape architecture program at the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning at the Technion. On top of teaching classes such as history of landscape architecture, seminars on documentation and preservation of historic gardens and studio classes, she was involved in academic funded research projects (including "Landscape and Recreation in the Galilee", 1966-67; "Playing Fields – Planning Guidelines", 1970-71; "Protection of Urban Desert Landscape", 1989-90). Her main academic research was about quarries rehabilitation, Kibbutzim landscape (Enis and Ben Arav. 1994. *Sixty Years of Kibbutz Gardens and Landscape* (1910–1970)), and Ahlem graduates work in Israel (Enis. 1998. "The Impact of the Israelitische Gartenbauschule Ahlem on Landscape Architecture in Israel." *Die Gartenkunst*).

Enis was also involved in numerous survey and research endeavors as part of her professional and academic work. She took part in survey and planning teams in Israel sponsored by different governmental organizations (including "Banyas, Landscape and Recreation Survey and Plan, for Israel Land Administration, Nature Reserve Authority", and the Regional Council of the Upper Galilee, 1968-69; "Quarries and Landscape: Analysis of the Problem and Recommendation", for the Ministry of Interior and the Ministry of Development and Israel Land Administration, 1971-72; "The Recreation Demands and Potential of the National Park Carmel", for the Nature Reserve Authority and Ministry of Tourism and the Jewish National Fund, 1972-74; "Landscape Evolution for the City of Modiin", for the Ministry of Public Works and Housing, 1994-95).

3 SCOPE AND CONTENTS

The collection's material was given by Enis to Professor Lissovsky's guardianship, while Enis still holds the rights. The material comprises of only a fragment of Enis collection, the rest of which is still located in her private home. It

is unknown why these specific materials and not others were given to Lissovsky. We found the materials arranged in marked boxes (labeled: books, students' work, correspondence, etc.) and large office binders marked by Enis (mostly research materials and slides collection). Some of the material, mostly regarding design projects, including the plans, had already been surveyed by other researchers who had partly arranged them in recent years. It is unknown whether the original order had been kept, but we assume that it was not. We rearranged these materials according to context. Most of the material was found in good condition.

Wherever possible, the original order of Enis' papers was preserved. The most significant change in arrangement we made was in Enis' correspondence files. These were found with no particular order (neither by years nor by names) and some letters were found in random files. Therefore, we re-arranged the letters by name of author or recipient in order to be more cohesive for future researchers. The series can be distinguished according to various aspects in Enis' career: her work as a landscape architect, her scholarly career as a researcher of landscape architecture, and her academic career as a professor at the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning in the Technion.

Series I – Design Project: This series contains material of design projects by Enis. The first subseries is *Plans and Maps in Large Format*: the material is rolled or flattened and kept in two plans-drawers. These are plans in different scales, including garden plans, planting plans, details of projects ranging between schools, parks, Kibbutzim, private houses and more. The poor physical condition of the material does not allow scholars access at this point. The plans and maps are arranged by project names. While a better and more precise archival arrangement of the maps and plans would be favorable, it is not possible at the moment due to the condition of the maps and plans and the available storage facility. The second subseries *Plans and Maps* includes plans and maps originally folded and arranged in folders by projects. These include her large project of quarries rehabilitation, plans for a consultation project in Ashdod and others (B01/f01- B01/f05). The third subseries, *Correspondence and Documents*, includes documents and letters regarding design projects (B01/f06 - /B01/f07). The last subseries holds Enis' project publications (B02).

Series II – Scholarly Work: The series contains material regarding Enis' work as a scholar of landscape architecture. This series includes the subseries *Documents* with material regarding her work (e.g. research proposals, correspondence regarding her publication and more). The second subseries *Involvement in Professional Organizations* holds specifically documents regarding her engagement in international and national professional organizations (ECLAS, IFLA, IUFRO, DoCoMoMo, The Council for Conservation of Heritage Sites in Israel (*Mo'atsah le-shimur atare moreshet be-Yisrael*), and more). The third subseries *Research Material* contains material collected by Enis for her own research. This includes two main research projects, namely her study on Kibbutzim – which contains materials she collected, as well as her students' research papers on Kibbutzim (B06/f07 –B08/f07); and her study on Ahlem graduates which contains files on each graduate including interviews, and materials received from the graduate or his family (B04/f01 - B06/f01). It also contains a full draft of her book with Yosef Ben Arav on the landscape of Kibbutzim (Enis and Ben Arav (1994), *Sixty Years of Kibbutz Gardens and Landscape* [Hebrew]).

Series III – Technion - teaching and administration: This series contains material regarding Enis' work as a faculty member at the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning at the Technion. The first subseries, *Administration*, contains administration papers regarding financial matters, general circulars, faculty letters and administration documents etc. The second series, *Teaching*, contains files with printed slides for lectures. Subseries 3, *Students*, includes student advisory files, and a classified file which contains reference and recommendation letters by Enis to others (B10/f12). This file cannot be accessed by researchers. Subseries 4, *Undergraduate Students' Papers*, contains students' papers collected by Enis. Enis' original order was kept, and papers are arranged mostly by topic and not by name of student, class or year. Some papers are in large A3 format and are kept in larger archival boxes.

Series IV - Other professional work: This series contains one file regarding Enis professional consultant work on design projects by others (B11/f08)

Series V – Correspondence: This series contains Enis' correspondence files on all aspect of her career. It includes letter Enis received, which are now filed in the subseries *Incoming* (B15/f01- B15/f10) and letters by Enis to others (drafts, copies and faxes original), now filed in the subseries *Outgoing* (B16/f01- B16/f10). Letters in German, Dutch, and English are arranged by roman alphabetical orders (Incoming: B15/f01- B15/f06; Outgoing: B16/f01- B16/f06), letters in Hebrew were filed separately and arranged by Hebrew alphabetical order (Incoming: B15/f07- B15/f09; Outgoing: B16/f07- B16/f09), in both subseries (*Incoming* and *Outgoing*). The alphabetical order is by last name of writer or recipient. In many cases the writer/recipient's last name is not written on the letter itself. These names were tracked in other letters or by extensive research. Two examples are extensive correspondence between Enis and

Annelise Nassuth and Doortje Haan. While both full names don't appear on the letter (to Enis, or from Enis), we were able to understand through the letters' contents and other descriptive notes who these persons were. Full names are written in pencil on the binders. In a small number of cases (single letter from writer/ to recipients) where the last name was not found, letters are arranged by private name. An effort was made to arrange all letters from specific writer / to specific recipient together in a binder. The series also contains letter to Enis by unknown, letters to unknown by Enis, and letters by others to others which were found among Enis' letters. The correspondence is related to Enis' work at the Technion and her scholarly work and includes letters from Sven Ingvar Anderson, Gerda Golwitzer, Kenneth Helphand, Ita Heinze-Greenberg, Paul Freiberg, Annemarie Lund, Ronald Lovinger, Arthur Lieberman, Dusan Orgin, Marc Trieb, Martha Schwartz, Achva Stein, Mordechai Schechter, Ann Whiston Spirn, Erv Zube and Joachim Wolschke-Bulmahn, among others. The last subseries *Personal Correspondence* includes letters to and from Enis regarding personal and family matters and includes holiday greeting cards, letters to the Enis family received during sabbaticals and others (B16/f11).

Series VI – Slides Collection: This is a collection of albums of slides of photos taken by Enis. Most photos were taken by Enis while travelling in Europe and North America. Some albums contain slides for teaching lectures and include reproduction of photos, maps, and plans from books. The collection is arranged by the proximate purpose of slides: Travelling (B17/f02- B19/f04), Teaching (B19/f05- B20/f02), Mixed (B20/f03- B20/f06). Slides were kept in the 27 original ring binders (in only once case, due to the folder's poor condition slides were taken out and moved to cardboard folder) arranged by Enis. The bulk of slides were found in good condition, some were damaged but were kept in their original place. We found a hand-written list of slides binders made by Enis (B17/f01), but as we couldn't find the original marking on most binder we renumbered them by type (travelling, teaching, mixed) and then alphabetically.

Series VII – Printed Matter: this series contains materials collected by Enis. Materials are arranged in 3 subseries: *Collected Materials* (B21/01 –B22/03) contains postcards collection, a collection of tourist maps and booklets and leaflets from Enis' travelling, papers not directly connected to her research and other materials; The second subseries - *Historical Research* (B21/04 –B22/07) contains articles (not by Enis) collected for specific subjects. The third subseries contains *Journals and Magazines*. A list of journals is attached in Annex 1. Annex 2 contains a list of books found in the Enis collection and transferred with her permission to the Faculty of Architecture and Town Planning library with a specially prepared Professor Enis ex-libris. The bulk of the books was from the J.J. Levinson library and holds his ex-libris. It is unknown when Enis received the books and which ones were part of her day-to-day library.

Series VIII – Photos and objects: The series contains photos taken by Enis or others, including many historic air-photos of Palestine/Israel, photos taken in quarries, probably for her extensive research and design projects in quarries rehabilitation, and travel pictures arranged in large album. This series also contains a bulk of developed films of Enis' photographs, some contains photographs of Enis' students' presentations.

Series IX – Crypto Collections:

This series hold three crypto collections of J.J. Levinson (1881 – unknown), Yaccov Shoor (1903-1977) and Yosef Ben Arav (1912-1998). The first contains a lecture book by Levinson, an American landscape architect, a lectures book from his studies at Yale University, dated 1903-1904. This lecture book was found with Levinson's book collection which was part of Enis' book collection. It is unknown when, why and how these were given to Enis. The Shoor collection includes materials received from Shoor, an Ahlem graduate from Kibbutz Ashdot Yaacov Meuhad, who worked as a gardener and landscape designer. Materials were probably given to Enis by Shoor's descendants for her Ehlem Graduates research. The collection contains paper by Shoor ("Gardening in Israel", 1956), letters from institutions and other gardeners, lists of plants, and some personal letters. Material in the Shoor collection are dating 1940-1956. The Ben Arav collection holds research materials collected by Ben Arav, a Kibbutz gardener and an author of several book about gardening, regarding gardens and landscapes in Israel, including copies of plans, articles and photos (some by Ben Arav), and index cards with Ben Arav's notes. It also includes his research on gardens in the Middle East and Muslim countries. It is unknown when did Enis received this collection.
