East Germany's political transition and Transitional Justice processes have faced major political and societal challenges since 1990. Not only did the country have to deal with its own communist and unjust past in legal and political terms, it also had to reconcile and unite with a different West Germany society that had developed different political and historical narratives since 1945. Dr. Anna Kaminsky, Director of the Federal Foundation for dealing with the GDR, will give a Keynote lecture highlighting the difficulties and challenges of reuniting and reconciling East German military and political elites into the new united German political and societal regime. The lecture will be followed by a discussion with Prof. Manuela Consonni from the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and Dr. Anja Mihr, DAAD visiting lecturer at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem, highlighting some of the measures and mechanism of coming to terms with the past, and the unreconciled issues among formerly divided societies or countries - in the case of Germany more than a generation after unification of East and West in 1990.
