



Call for Applications

The Franz Rosenzweig Minerva Research Center for German-Jewish Literature and Cultural History at The Hebrew University of Jerusalem seeks a managing editor of the centre's journal: Naharaim.

As part of the Center's commitment to high-level scholarly publication in German-Jewish studies, the centre issues a biannual journal: *Naharaim: Zeitschrift für deutsch-jüdische Literatur und Kulturgeschichte* (De Gruyter). Naharaim is a peer-reviewed publication, coordinated by a three-editor team. Naharaim publishes the research of internationally-acclaimed scholars of German-Jewish culture. Recent issues have included sections devoted to special themes like "Jewish Orientalism," "Yiddish in German and German-Jewish Culture," "German-Israeli Cooperation in the Humanities and in Cultural Politics", and "Tangled Heritage: Jewish Publishing Culture in the Inter-War Period".

The managing editor is responsible for:

- proactive planning of future issues (one or two a year) together with the journal editors, and if relevant, together with guest editor
- work with editors, authors, reviewers, language editors and copy editors through the ScholarOne automated submissions and review system:
- choosing and inviting suitable reviewers for new submissions
- decision-making with regard to submissions, based on reviews
- Supervising production schedule
- publicity: Call for papers and announcement of new issues on H-Judaic, H-Germanistik etc.

This call is open to scholars of all nationalities and of varied backgrounds, with expertise in areas such as German-Jewish Intellectual History, Cultural History, Philosophy, and Literature. Applicants must have excellent knowledge of the German and English languages.
